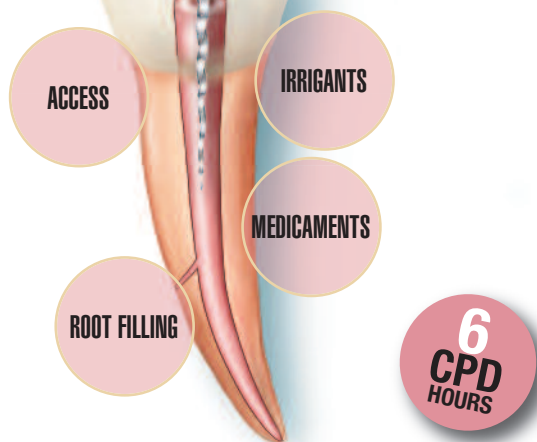

From Root to Restoration

This is a truly unique endodontic course. It will answer all those questions that you may have wondered about endodontics in your practice. It will help you improve your endodontic treatment and get the results you want! The focus will be on common pitfalls that practitioners face in day-to-day practice and the latest technological advances.

Rotary NiTi has made endodontic treatment easier and enables predictable obturation results. This full day hands-on course is designed for first time users of rotary, those who want to perfect their technique, or for a general update in endodontics.

Course Objectives:

- **Canal anatomy** - learn how to recognise and manage complex canal anatomy. Learn how to find and negotiate MB2 and 2nd distal canals of mandibular molar!
- **Access** - Learn how to improve your access cavity outline and straight-line access.
- **Negotiating difficult canals** - Learn how to identify and negotiate ledges, curved and calcified canals.
- **Working length** - Learn how to use apex locators to get more accurate working lengths.
- **Irrigants and medicaments** - Understand which irrigants (chlorhexidine, sodium hypochlorite and EDTA) should be used to establish the best outcome. Ledermix and/or calcium hydroxide medicaments will be explained.
- **Rotary NiTi instrumentation & Twisted file (TF)** - learn and experience the advantages of latest NiTi technology.
- **Filling techniques and root fillings** - learn and experience the advantages of bonded root fillings and bonded carrier root fillings (RealSeal and Soft-Core).
- **Coronal restorations** - learn the importance of coronal seal and how to place orifice plugs.

There will be an open discussion forum where you will be able to ask questions and also discuss some of your own cases. Each participant is encouraged to bring endodontic x-rays from their practice for discussion.

Participants are also encouraged to bring accessed extracted teeth as well as safety glasses & loupes. All other materials will be provided. Two posterior and two anterior teeth are recommended. Please access these prior to the course.

Dr. Michelle Heffernan is the Head of Discipline of Endodontics at the University of Sydney. She also treats patients in her specialist endodontic private practice, BMA House Endodontists, on Macquarie Street in Sydney.
