4. FIRST AID MEASURES

For advice, contact a Poisons Information Centre (Australia: 13 1126, New Zealand: 0800 764 766) or a doctor at once. NEVER induce swallowing in an unconscious person.

In the event of splashes or contact with eyes:

If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. Continue flushing until advised to stop by the Poisons Information Centre or a doctor, or for at least 15 minutes.

In the event of splashes or contact with skin:

Remove all contaminated or stained clothing immediately. Do not use them again until they have been decontaminated.

Wash the skin thoroughly with soap and water or a recognised cleaner.

In the event of swallowing:
